

## LEGACY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL Parent Notifications – Federal Programs – August 29, 2019

### Regarding Right to Receive Teacher Information:

Federal law requires that each school district receiving Title 1 funds notify parents of each student attending any school receiving these funds that information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher(s) may be requested. As a parent of a student attending a school receiving federal program funds, you have the right to know: Is my child's teacher licensed to teach the grades and subject(s) assigned? Is my child's teacher teaching with a provisional license, meaning the state has waived requirements for my child's teacher? What is the college major of my child's teacher? What degree or degrees does my child's teacher hold? If there are instructional aides working with my child, what are their qualifications? If my child is or will be taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks this year by a teacher who is not highly qualified, will I be notified in a timely manner? To request the state qualifications for your child's teacher or instructional aide, contact the school at 467-0947.

School Annual Report Card & Charter Commission Annual Report: Over Legacy's history, and no matter the assessments or reviews conducted, the school has continuously outperformed State academic outcomes, as well as nearby district outcomes. Parents and the community at large can access Legacy's Annual Report Card at [idahoschools.org](http://idahoschools.org) and typing in Legacy Charter School. You are also able to compare Legacy academic and other outcomes with other schools, districts and overall State data. Also, charter schools authorized by the Idaho Public Charter School Commission receive an Annual Report from the Commission that's available to the public. The report card shares the school's academic outcomes, operations & finances ratings. Legacy has received "Good" to "Honor" standings in all three areas – the strongest ratings attainable, and continues to operate with unanimous votes for recertification by the Charter Commission. Legacy's full reports can be found on our website under School Information, then Performance Certificate Annual Report. Last August, the Idaho State Dept. of Education named Legacy one of Idaho's 48 top-performing K-8 schools and one of its 158 "goal-maker" K-8 schools.
